22 Victoria – Chapter 52

An Act to establish Mark's Street, in the Parish of Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, as a Public Highway. Passed 13th April 1859.

Mark's Street in Saint Stephen, a public highway.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, — That the Road fifty feet wide designated and known as 'Mark's Street' upon Mahood's plan of the John Mark's property, in Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, be and the same is hereby made a Public Highway, and entitled to the benefit of the previsions of all or any of the Acts of Assembly relating to Highways in this Province, which may be applicable thereto.
