23 Victoria – Chapter 11

An Act to extend the provisions of Chapter 61, Title VIII, of the Revised Statutes, 'Of Fences, Trespasses, and Pounds,' to the City of Saint John. Passed 8th March 1860.

Chap. 61, Rev. Stat, in part extended to Saint John City.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, —That so much and such parts of Chapter 61, Title VIII, of the Revised Statutes of this Province, as relates to the erection of Fences, the power and duties of Fence Viewers, and the recovery and collection of the cost and expenses incurred in the making and repairing of line Fences by virtue thereof, shall extend to the City of Saint John and all lands therein; and the Common Council of the said City shall have power to appoint one or more Fence Viewers, who shall have the same power, authority, and rights, and be subject to the same responsibilities and duties within the said City, as any Fence Viewer elected or appointed for any Parish or District under the said Chapter now has or is subject to within such Parish or District.
