24 Victoria – Chapter 36

An Act to enable the Firewards of the Parish of Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, to increase the number of Firemen attached to the Saint Stephen Volunteer Fire Engine Company Number Two. Passed 12th April 1861.

The Firewards may increase the number of Firemen.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That notwithstanding anything contained in the first section of Chapter 59, of Title VIII, of the Revised Statutes, 'Of preventing Fires,' the Firewards of the Parish of Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, are hereby authorized and empowered to appoint by Warrant a sufficient number of able men, not exceeding sixty five, to the Saint Stephen Volunteer Fire Engine Company Number Two, whose appointments shall be registered in the manner provided in the said above recited Act.
