25 Victoria – Chapter 4

An Act to authorize an Assessment in the City of Saint John, to meet the expenses incurred by the Corporation for the Prince of Wales' Celebration. Passed 29th March 1862.

Corporation authorized to assess.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the City of Saint John have incurred considerable expense for the recent reception in that City of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the said Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the City of Saint John be and they are hereby authorized to order an assessment on the City of Saint John, and the inhabitants thereof, of the sum of three thousand two hundred dollars, together with the expenses of assessing and collecting; which said sums, together with all interest paid, due, or which may become due, up to the time of the payment thereof, shall be assessed, levied and collected in the same manner as any assessment made under the provisions of "The Saint John City Assessment Act of 1859:" Provided nevertheless, that the assessment under this Act shall not be levied or assessed upon any person whose whole assessment for the said City in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty one did not amount to twelve dollars, and they are hereby exempted from the operation of this Act.
