25 Victoria – Chapter 69

**An Act to repeal an Act to incorporate the Town of Moncton. Passed 23rd April 1862.**

Section.

1. Acts 18 V. c. 66, 19 V. c. 61, and 22 V. c. 45, repealed.

Section.

2. Bye Laws, &c. under said Acts to continue in force.

Whereas the Act intituled *An Act to incorporate the Town of Moncton*, has proved unsuitable to the small population comprised within the limits of the said Town, and the great expense incurred annually in carrying out the provisions of the same is entirely disproportionate to the advantages contemplated thereby;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. That an Act made and passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Town of Moncton*; also an Act intituled *An Act to amend, the Act intituled 'An Act to incorporate the Town of Moncton,'* and passed in the nineteenth year of Her present Majesty's Reign; and also an Act intituled *An Act to amend the Act intituled 'An Act to incorporate the Town of Moncton.'* and passed in the twenty second year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, be and the same are hereby repealed; provided that so much of the said Acts hereby repealed shall continue and be in force as to enable the present Mayor, Town Councillors and Assessors elected for the ensuing year, and the Town Clerk and Treasurer, who shall continue in office and shall have power and be compelled within two years after the passing of this Act, to make, levy and collect assessments for the purpose of winding up and closing the affairs of the said Corporation, and liquidating all debts and liabilities incurred by the said Corporation; which sums, when ascertained and adjusted, together with the expenses incurred in winding up the said business, and the compensation allowed the officers engaged in the purpose aforesaid, shall be assessed, apportioned, levied and collected on the property and rate-payers situate and being in the said Town of Moncton; and all officers appointed by the said Corporation shall continue in office until the government of the said Town shall be administered by the General Sessions of the Peace for the County of Westmorland, at the next annual meeting to be holden at Dorchester on the second Tuesday in December, under the provisions of the Acts of Assembly.

2. All bye laws, rules and regulations heretofore made for the government of the said Town, shall continue in force and effect, and all breaches of the same, and all fines and penalties and bonds may be enforced, sued for and recovered by the said Mayor and Town Councillors, during their continuance in office, so far as the same are in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts hereby repealed, notwithstanding the repeal of the said Acts.
