26 Victoria – Chapter 15

An Act to provide for Securities to be given by Public Officers in this Province. Passed 20th April, 1863.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,---That in all cases where no provision is already made by law for security to be given by Public Officers, every person appointed or hereafter to be appointed to any office, employment or commission under the Government, wherein he shall be concerned in the collection, receipt, disbursement or expenditure or any public money, shall execute a Bond to the Queen, in such sum and with such sufficient surety or sureties as may be approved of by the Governor in Council, for the faithful discharge of his duties, and for his duly accounting for all public moneys received by him or entrusted to his control.
