27 Victoria – Chapter 48

**An Act to explain an Act relating' to Lands required for Railway purposes. Passed 13th April, 1864.**

Whereas an Act passed in the nineteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act relating to Lands required for Railway purposes*: And whereas doubts may exist whether the provisions of that Act extend to lands necessary for the continuation of the present line from the principal Station at Saint John to deep water in the Harbour of Saint John; for remedy whereof,—

Be it enacted and declared by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

That the provisions of the said recited Act, intituled *An Act relating to Lands requited for Railway purposes*, and each and every of them, be deemed and taken to apply to all lands which may be required for the purpose of extending any Line or Lines of Railway from the present principal terminus in Saint John to any part of the City of Saint John, or to any deep water terminus in the Harbour of Saint John, and to all lands required for Stations, or Depots, or other purposes connected with any such Line of Railway, to all intents and purposes; and all the powers given by the said recited Act to the Governor, Commissioners, Appraisers or other officers or persons named or mentioned therein, shall and may extend to and be exercised by them respectively.
