27 Victoria – Chapter 53

An Act to establish an additional Polling place in the Parish of Shippegan, in the County of Gloucester. Passed 13th April, 1864.

Section. Section.

1. Additional Polling place, where situate.

2. Districts Nos. 1 and 2; locality.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. That in addition to the Polling place "at or near the Church at Shippegan [Shippagan]," in the Parish of Shippegan [Shippagan], in the County of Gloucester, as now appointed by the provisions of the twenty fifth Section of an Act made and passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to regulate the election of Members to serve in the General Assembly*, the following shall be an additional Polling place in the said Parish of Shippegan [Shippagan], for all electors residing or entitled to vote in that part of the said Parish which forms Shippegan [Shippagan] and Miscou Islands, that is to say,— at or near the Church at Gross Point on Shippegan [Shippagan] Island.
- 2. The said Islands of Shippegan [Shippagan] and Miscou shall be distinguished as District number two, and the remaining part of the said Parish as District number one.
