28 Victoria – Chapter 58

An Act to repeal the Act for changing the Shire Town of King's County from Kingston to Sussex. Passed 8th June, 1865.

Whereas the proposed removal of the Shire Town of King's County from Kingston to Sussex is not in accordance with the wishes of a large proportion of the inhabitants of the said County;— Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the Act made and passed in the twenty seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled An Act to establish the Shire Town of King's County, and to provide for the procuring a site for, and the erection of the Public Buildings in the Parish of Sussex within the same, be and the same is hereby repealed.
