28 Victoria – Chapter 6

## An Act relating to Marriage and Divorce. Passed 8th June, 1865.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That all Affidavits and Oaths to be taken and administered in any matter now or that hereafter may be pending in the Court of Divorce and Matrimonial Causes, as also in all suits and proceedings for Divorce or nullity of Marriage pending in tile Court of Governor and Council, (in which evidence has been taken and examined prior to the ninth day of April, A. D. 1860,) may be taken and administered by any Commissioner for taking Affidavits to be read in the Supreme Court.
