30 Victoria – Chapter 16

An Act to amend the second Section of Sub-Chapter 1, of the Act of Assembly 17th Victoria, Chapter 18, intituled *An Act relating to the administration of Justice in Equity*. Passed 17th June 1867.

Supreme Court in Equity to exercise powers given to Court of Chancery and Lord Chancellor by Imperial Acts 13 & 14 Vic. cap. 60, and 15 & 16 Vic. cap. 55.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, —That the powers and authorities given by the Acts of the British Parliament 13th and 14th Victoria, Chapter 60, called "The Trustee Act, 1850," and the 15th and 16th Victoria, Chapter 55, to the Court of Chancery and the Lord Chancellor in England, and extended by the said Acts to the Colonies belonging to Her Majesty, shall and may be exercised in like manner by, and are hereby given to the Supreme Court in Equity in the Province of New Brunswick, with respect to all lands and personal estate in the said Province, and shall be allowed and taken as a part of the Law and system of proceeding in the said Court.
