30 Victoria – Chapter 19

An Act in addition to and in amendment of an Act intituled *An Act to incorporate the Woodstock Railway Company*. Passed 17th June 1867.

Company empowered to construct additional Lines.

Whereas certain persons were incorporated by an Act of Assembly made and passed in the twenty seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Woodstock Railway Company*, with certain powers and privileges in the said Act set forth: And whereas it is desirable that the said Woodstock Railway Company, their successors and assigns, shall be empowered to construct and build such other lines of Railway in the Counties of Carleton and Victoria, as they may think proper, subject in all respects to the like conditions, powers and privileges in the said recited Act;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, —That the Woodstock Railway Company, and their successors and assigns, are and i they are hereby empowered to construct and build such line or lines of Railway in the Counties of Carleton and Victoria, and the Parish of Southampton in the County of York, as they may think proper, subject in all respects to the conditions, powers and privileges made incident and granted to the said Woodstock Railway Company, in and by an Act of Assembly made and passed in the twenty seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Woodstock Railway Company*.
