30 Victoria – Chapter 23

An Act to establish an additional Polling place in the Parish of Grand Falls, in the County of Victoria. Passed 17th June 1867.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the following additional Polling place for the Election of Members to serve in the General Assembly, shall be and is hereby established,—At or near George Ballard's, in the Parish of Grand Falls, for all Electors residing or entitled to vote in that part of the said Parish which lies south of the northern line of a tract of land granted to Barnabas M'Laughlan, being Lot No. 29, and the prolongation of the said line westerly to the American Boundary Line, and their prolongation of said line easterly, crossing the River Saint John, till it meets the division line between the Parishes of Grand Falls and Gordon,—The above described part of the said Parish to be distinguished as District Number Two, and the remaining part as District Number One.
