30 Victoria – Chapter 59

An Act to revive and continue the several Acts of Assembly for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton, so far as the same relate to the Upper Woodstock Road District. Passed 17th June 1867.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That an Act made and passed in the ninth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to provide for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock*, and also an Act made and passed in the tenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act in addition to and in amendment of an Act intituled An Act to provide for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock*, be and the same are hereby severally revived, continued, and declared to be in full force and effect, until the first day of June which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy, in the District known as the Upper District in the said Parish of Woodstock, as set apart by the twelfth Chapter of eighteenth of Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to divide the Shire Town of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton, into two separate Districts, for Road and Fire purposes*.
