30 Victoria – Chapter 79

An Act to provide for the erecting of a Town Hall in the Parish of Saint David, in the County of Charlotte. Passed 17th June 1867.

1. Justices authorized to contract for erection
of Town Hall.

Section.

2. Assessment for cost of erection.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. It shall and may be lawful for the Justices of the Peace in and for the County of Charlotte, at any General or Special Sessions called for that purpose, to contract and agree with able and competent workmen for the erecting, in the Parish of Saint David, in the County of Charlotte, near the head of Oak Bay, a suitable Building for a Town Hall, for such sum not exceeding three hundred dollars, as may be necessary for that purpose.

2. The Justices aforesaid are authorized to order an assessment on the inhabitants of the said Parish for the amount aforesaid, together with the expense of assessing and collecting the same, to be assessed, levied and collected as other Parish rates.
