CAP. X.

An ACT to make perpetual an Act passed in the Fourth Year of His Majesty's Reign, entituled "An Act for the relief of Insolvent Debtors taken in execution."

[6th May, 1836.]

W HEREAS an Act was passed in the Fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, entituled "An Act for the relief of Insolvent Debtors taken in 4 W. 4 (Sess. 2) execution," which it was therein declared should continue in force for cap. 11: Two Years and no longer: And whereas it is necessary that the same should be continued and made perpetual:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly of Newfoundland, that the said Act shall be, and the same is hereby perpetual.
