CAP. IV.

An Act to make provision for the greater protection of the Revenue at the Port of St. John's.

[Passed 12th October, 1839.]

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for the greater protection Preamble. and the more effectual Collection of the Revenue in the Port of St. John's:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly of Sum of £200 grant-Newfoundland, in General Assembly convened, that from and out of ed for establishing a Preventive Boat at the Monies in the hands of the Treasurer of Newfoundland, and unap- St. John's. propriated, there be Granted to Her Majesty, Her Heirs, and Successors, the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds, towards establishing a Preventive Boat in the said Port, for the better protection of the Revenue.

II.—And be it further enacted, that it shall and may be lawful for Governor to establish Excellency the Governor to establish a Preventive Boat, with a lish such Boat and Crew of Four Revenue Boatmen; such Boat shall be placed under be under the control the Superintendance and Control of the Collector of Her Majesty's of the Collector. III .- And be it further enacted, that this Act shall continue and be Limitation of Act, in force until the last Day of November, in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty.
