CAP. VIII.

An Act to repeal part of an Act passed in the second Session of the first General Assembly of this Island, intituled "An Act to regulate the Building of Houses in Water Street in the Town of St. John's.

[Passed 12th October, 1839.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to make further provision for regulating the building of Houses in Water Street, in the Town of St. John's. Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly of Newfoundland, in General Assembly convened, and by the authority of the same, that from and after the passing of this Act the Second and Seventh Sections of the Act 4th William the Fourth, Chapter the Third, be and the same are hereby repealed. Sec. 2 and 7 of 4 W. 4 c. 3, repealed.

II.—*And be it further enacted*, that all Houses, Stores, Buildings, and Erections whatsoever, which shall or may at any time or times hereafter, be raised, built, or erected, on the North side of Water Street aforesaid, shall be built, made, and erected, entirely of Stone or Bricks and be covered with Slates, Tiles, Iron, Tin or Copper. All Houses, &c. hereafter erected on North side of Water Street to be of Stone.

III.—*And be it further enacted*, that all and every part of the Sixth Section of the said Act of Fourth William the Fourth, Chapter the Third, be made to apply to all and every violation or infringement of this Act. Infringements of this Act.
