CAP. V.

An Act to continue an Act made and passed in the Second Year of the Reign of Her prese Majesty, intituled "An Act for the Regulation of Pilots and the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Saint John's."

[Passed 26th April, 1841.]

WHEREAS an Act was made and passed in the Second Year of Preamble. the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "An Act for the Regula- 2 vic. Cap. 6. tion of Pilots and the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of St. John's," which said Act will speedily expire, and it is expedient and necessary to continue the same.

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly of Act herein recited Newfoundland, that the said recited Act, and every matter, clause and further continued in thing therein contained be and the same are hereby continued for the thing therein contained, be and the same are hereby continued for the period of One Year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the Legislature.
