CAP. XI.

An ACT to Continue an Act passed in the Third Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to amend several Acts now in force respecting Light-Houses and to make further provision for the said Light-Houses, and to Consolidate the Laws respecting the same."

[Passed 23rd April, 1845.]

W HEREAS an Act was passed in the Third Year of the Reign of Preamble. Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to amend several Acts now in force respecting Light-Houses, and to make further provision for the said Light-Houses, and to Consolidate the Laws respecting the same," which, as was therein provided, was to continue in force for the period of Three Years, and thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly; and whereas by subsequent Acts of the Legislature the said Act has been from time to time continued, but will shortly expire, and it is expedient that the same should be continued for a further period :

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, that the said recited Act shall be, and Act 3 Vie, cap. 5. the same is hereby continued for the period of One Year from the continued one passing of this Act, and thence to the end of the then next Session ^{year.} of the Legislature:
