CAP. XVI.

An ACT to provide for the Contingent Expenses of the Legislature during the present Session.

[Passed 23rd April, 1845.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Contingent Expenses of the Legislature :

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, that from and out of such monies as may from time to time remain in the hands of the Treasurer, unappropriated, there be granted to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, the sum of Three Thousand One Hundred and Sixty-eight Pounds \pounds_{3168} 19s. 10d Nineteen Shillings and Ten Pence, to be appropriated towards remu- to be approprianerating the Officers of the Legislature for their services, and towards ted as followsdefraying the Contingent Expenses of the Legislature during the present Session, as follows, that is to say :


