CAP. VIII.

AN ACT for the Encouragement of the Bank Fishery.

[Passed 23rd April, 1845.]

HEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Encouragement of the Preamble.

Bank Cod-Fishery of this Colony:

I.—Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, That there be granted a Bounty of A bounty of 30s. Thirty Shillings per Ton on each of such Three Vessels as, being fitted to Vessels on out for the prosecution of the Bank Cod Fishery on the Bultoe system, certain condiby a Person or Persons resident or carrying on business in this Colony, tions. and having prosecuted such Fishery, in the manner aforesaid, for any fishing season during the continuance of this Act, shall land in this Colony the greatest quantity of Cod-fish, the produce of such Fishery during such season as aforesaid, for each man of the Crew of such Vessels respectively. Provided always, that no such sum to be paid as aforesaid for any Vessel, shall exceed the sum of Two Hundred Pounds.

II.—And be it further enacted, that the Bounties herein granted shall be paid to the party or parties entitled to the same by Warrant on the Mode of payment Colonial Treasurer, on proof being given to the satisfaction of the of bounty.
