CAP. IV.

AN ACT for granting a further Sum for establishing a Lunatic Asylum in Saint John's.

[Passed 14th January, 1847.]

WHEREAS by an Act made and passed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act for the establishment of a Lunatic Asylum in Saint John's," power is thereby given to the Governor or Person Administering the Government for the time being, to draw from and out of the Treasury the Sum of Fifteen Hundred Pounds, for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of the said Act. And Whereas it has been found that the said Sum of Money is totally insufficient and inadequate for the purpose of the said Act :

Preamble.

9th Vic. Cap. 1.

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Legislative Assembly convened, That it shall be lawful for the Governor or Person Administering the Government for the time being, by Warrant under his Hand and Seal, to draw from and out of such monies as may be in the hands of the Treasurer the further Sum of Fifteen Hundred Pounds for the purpose of carrying into effect the object and provisions of the said recited Act.

A further sum of £1500 granted for the establishment of a Lunatic Asylum.
