CAP. XVIII.

AN ACT for Granting to Her Majesty the Sum of Five Thousand Pounds for the Making and Repairing of Main Roads and Bridges in this Colony.

[Passed 23d April, 1849.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Internal Improvement Prenumble. of the Colony, by the Making and Repairing of Roads and Bridges therein:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in The sum of £5000 Legislative Session convened, that from and out of such Monies as may granted for making and refrom time to time remain in the hands of the Treasurer, unappropriated, pairing of Main there be Granted to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, the Sum of Five Thousand Pounds for the Opening, Making, and Repairing, of Main Roads and Bridges in this Colony; which Sum shall be expended by the Governor and Council in such of the Districts of this Colony, where Destitution may prevail, as they shall select for the purposes aforesaid.
