## CAP. VII.

> AN ACT to Repeal in part an Act passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her Present Majesty, entitled "An Act to Contimue and Amend an Act passed in the Fousth Year of the Reign of Her Present Majesty, entitled ' An Act to Regulate the Packing and Inspection of Pickled Fish for Exportation from this Colomy.'"

[Passed 23d April, 1849.]

WHRREAS an Act was passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her preamble. present Majesty, entitled "An Act to continue and amend an Act passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled 'An Acr to Regulate the Packing and Inspection of Pickled Fish for Exportation from this Colony;'" And whereas it is expedient to amend the same:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, in muty imposeif Legislative Session convened, that so much of the said recited Act as upon the osporta imposes a Duty upon the Exportation from this Colony, to any part of the in hulls tor Brinth British Dominions, of Herrings in Bulk, whether Fresh, Salted, or Pickled, dominions be and the same is hereby Repealed.
II.-And be it further cnacled, that the Master of every Vessel in which bond to te wwen any such Herrings, as aforesaid, shall be intended to be Exported from "y mater.n veenet this Colony, shall, before any such Vessel shall be Cleared outwards, expontatiun of enter into a Bond to Her Majesty for the Payment of a sum equal to the herrings for Duties liable to be charged upon the Cargo of the said Vessel under the paymentornaun Dus fiable to be hars impsed by thit
 said Bond shall be cancelled upon the production, within One Year after the date of the said Bond, to the Officer in this Colony appointed to celles withen nur receive Duties, of a Certificate, from some Person duly qualified to grant yar, on prodicthe same at the Port where such Vessel shall Enter and Discharge her canf tuat such Cargo, that such Herrings have been landed within the British dominions. herrings have
