CAP. XV.

AN ACT for Granting a further Sum of Money to Her Majesty for Establishing a Lunatic Asylum in Saint John's.

[Passed 15th June, 1853.]

7 HEREAS the several sums of Money hitherto granted by the Le- Preamble. gislature of this Colony to Her Majesty, for the erection and establishment of a Lunatic Asylum therein, have been found insufficient for that purpose :--

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, that there be granted to Her Majesty the $of \pm 2,250$ for further sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Pounds; which erection of Lunasaid sum shall be raised and applied in the manner and for the purposes tic Asylum, &c. mentioned in an Act passed by the Legislature of this Colony in the Fifteenth Year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to repeal the Acts respecting the establishment of a Lunatic Asylum at Saint John's, and to make other provision in lieu thereof."
