AN ACT to Unite the Offices of Colonial Treasurer, and Collector of Her Majesty's Customs and Revenue at the Port of Saint John's, into one Office.

[Passed 4th August, 1855.]

7 HEREAS it is expedient that the Offices of Colonial Treasurer for Preamble. this Island, and Collector of Her Majesty's Customs and Revenue at the Port of St. John's, should be united and form but one Office.

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened;

I.—That the said Offices of Colonial Treasurer for this Island, and Revenue to be Collector of Her Majesty's Customs and Revenue at the Lot. of thereof discharged by Receiver. Collector of Her Majesty's Customs and Revenue at the Port of St. united, and duties charged by an Officer to be called the Receiver General.

III.—Wherever the Term Colonial Treasurer, or Collector, or Prin- Construction of cipal Officer of Customs at the Port of St. John's, occurs, or is used in Terms. any Act, Law, or Proceeding of any Nature or Kind soever, such Term shall be construed to mean Receiver General.

IV .- The Receiver General shall give good and sufficient Security to Her Majesty, to be approved of by the Governor in Council, for the to give Securities due Collection, Sefe Magning and Dispessed, of all such Marines, Property. due Collection, Safe Keeping, and Disposal, of all such Monies, Property, and Securities, as may be received by him the said Receiver General, and for the faithful discharge of all the duties of his Office.
