CAP. IX.

AN ACT to provide for the Salary of the Governor of this Island.

[Passed 4th August, 1855.]

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary to make provision for the Preamble Salary of the Governor of this Island, after the death, resignation or removal of the present Incumbent, according to the means and ability of the People of this Island:

I.-Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council, £2000 per annum. and Assembly of Newfoundland, that there be granted to Her Majesty, to be granted as Her Heirs and Successors, out of the Public Revenue of this Island, in every Year, the sum of Two Thousand Pounds Sterling, to defray the Island hereafter Salary of any Person who shall hereafter be appointed Governor of this appointed. Island and its Dependencies; which said Sum shall be paid Quarterly by Warrant under the hand and seal of the Governor, upon the Receiver General of this Island.
