## CAP. X.

## AN ACT to Provide for the Contingent Expenses of the Legislature.

[Passed 17th March, 1857.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Contingent Expenses Preamble. of the Legislature of this Colony during the present Session :-

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, as follows:--

1.—That from and out of such Monies as shall from time to time £5,946 12s. 5d. remain in the hands of the Receiver General, and unappropriated, granted to defray the there be granted to Her Majesty the sum of Five Thousand Nine of the Legislature. Hundred and Forty-Six Pounds Thirteen Shillings and Five Pence, to be applied towards remunerating the Officers of the Legislature for their services, and towards defraying the Contingent Expenses of the Legislative Council and the House of Assembly, during the present Session, as follows:—
