## CAP. IV.

AN ACT to continue the Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, imported into this Colony and its Dependencies.

[Passed 17th March, 1857.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Nineteenth Year of the Freezel. Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, imported into this Colony and its Dependencies," which, as was therein declared, was to continue and be in force for One Year from the passing thereof, and which Act will expire on the Twelfth day of May next; and it is expedient to continue the said Act for the period of One Year therefrom:
