CAP. XI.

AN ACT to provide for the erection of a Light House on or near Brunette Island, on the Western Coast of this Island.

[Passed 20th April, 1859.]

WHEREAS it is considered necessary that a Light House should Preamble be erected on or near Brunette Island, on the Western Coast of this Island.

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council and Governor in Council Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, that it shall be lawful for the to expend money no-cessary for the erec-Governor in Council to expend, out of such Light Dues as shall tion of Light House. remain in the hands of the Receiver-General, from time to time unappropriated, such sums of Money as shall be necessary and available towards the erection and support of a Light House on or near the said Island of Brunette.
