CAP. XII.

AN ACT to amend an Act passed in the Twentyfirst Year of the Reign of Her Majesty, entitled "An Act to provide for the performance of Contracts between Masters and Servants in this Colony."

[Passed 20th April, 1859.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-Preamble first Year of the Reign of Her Majesty, entitled "An Act for the performance of Contracts between Masters and Servants in this Colony."

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council and First Section of reci-Assembly, in Session convened, That so much of the First Section of agreements not to the said Act which requires that there shall be two parts of Agreement apply to Sealing between Masters and Servants, one to be in the possession of the Employer, and the other in possession of the Servant, shall not apply to Sealing Crews; and it shall be a sufficient compliance with the said Act, that in all Agreements with Sealing Crews aforesaid, there shall How Sealing agree-be two parts, respectively signed by the Master and the Crew; and ments to be executed, one part shall remain with the Master or Owner, and the other part posited. shall be left with any one of the Crew who shall be selected by them or a majority of them for that purpose.
