District of Brigus, lying between South side of Northern Gut, in Port-de-Grave, Salmon Cove, and Indian Pond, exclusive.

II.—The Saint John's Board shall thereafter be St. John's entitled to the proportionate annual Capitation Money Board entitled to the place so transferred for Educational purposes, according to the Act 21st Vic., Cap. 7.

## CAP. XVI.

An Act to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-seventh Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act for the amendment of the General Water Company Acts; and also of the Act for the Incorporation of the Harbour Grace Water Company."

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened:—

So much of the Sixteenth Section of the said Act 27 Vic, Cap 4, as imposes a rate of Five Cents per Ton (Registered Repealed. Tonnage) on Vessels engaged in the Coasting Trade of this Colony, and owned by Persons resident in the Vessels owned in several Districts of the Colony, except St. John's, to Districts other than St. John's, be paid at the first entry or clearance, at the Custom exempt from tax. House, in each year, shall be, and the same is hereby Repealed.
