4 William IV – Chapter 4 (Session 2)

An Act for granting to His Majesty the Sum of Five Hundred Pounds, Sterling, to be appropriated and applied towards defraying any Expenses which may arise in the event of the introduction and spreading of Asiatic Cholera in this Colony. (20th September, 1834.)

May it please your Excellency,

We, His Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects the Commons of Newfoundland, in Parliament assembled, having resolved to grant to His Majesty a Supply for the purposes hereinafter mentioned, do therefore beseech your Excellency that it may be enacted, and Be it enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, of Newfoundland, that from and out of the Monies which shall, from time to time, be and remain in the hands of the Treasurer of this Island, and unappropriated, there shall be Granted and Paid to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, a Sum not exceeding Five Hundred Pounds Sterling, to be appropriated and applied under such Orders as His Excellency the Governor in Council may, from time to time, give and make, for the purpose of defraying any necessary Expenses which may arise from the introduction and spreading of Asiatic Cholera in this Colony.
