9 Victoria – Chapter 7 (Session 2)

An Act to continue an Act passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to amend the Law now in force for the encouragement of the Whale Fishery of this Colony." (Passed 4th August, 1846.)

Whereas an Act was passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to amend the Law now in force for the encouragement of the Whale Fishery of this Colony," which, as was therein provided, was to continue in force for One Year, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the Legislature; And whereas the said Act will shortly expire, and it is expedient that it should be continued for a further period:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, That the said Act shall be and the same is hereby continued until the last day of December in this present Year.
