

*Laws of Her Majesty's Province of Newfoundland*, passed in the year 1849.

12 Victoria – Chapter 1

**An Act to continue an Act passed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares and Merchandise, imported into this Colony and its Dependencies.” (Passed 22d December, 1848.)**

Whereas an Act was passed in the Ninth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize imported into this Colony and its Dependencies,” which, as was therein declared, was to continue and be in force for the period of Eighteen Calendar Months from and after the Fifth day of July, in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-six: And whereas, by an Act passed in the Tenth Year of the Reign of Her Majesty, the said Act was to continue and be in force until the last day of December in the present year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-eight: And whereas it is expedient that the said Act should be continued for a further period:

- I. Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Council and Assembly of Newfoundland, in Legislative Session convened, that the said first-recited Act, and every clause, matter and thing therein contained, shall be and the same is hereby continued in full force and effect for Twelve Calendar Months from and after the last day of December in this present year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-eight, anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
- II. And be it further enacted, that this and the said Act may be repealed, altered or amended, by any Act or Acts to be passed in the present Session of the Legislature.
