

Laws of Her Majesty's Province of Newfoundland, passed in the year 1849.

12 Victoria – Chapter 7

An Act to Repeal in part an Act passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her Present Majesty, entitled “An Act to Continue and Amend an Act passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her Present Majesty, entitled ‘An Act to Regulate the Packing and Inspection of Pickled Fish for Exportation from this Colony.’” (Passed 23d April, 1849.)

Whereas an Act was passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act to continue and amend an Act passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled ‘An Act to Regulate the Packing and Inspection of Pickled Fish for Exportation from this Colony;’” And whereas it is expedient to amend the same:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, that so much of the said recited Act as imposes a Duty upon the Exportation from this Colony, to any part of the British Dominions, of Herrings in Bulk, whether Fresh, Salted, or Pickled, be and the same is hereby Repealed.

II. And be it further enacted, that the Master of every Vessel in which any such Herrings, as aforesaid, shall be intended to be Exported from this Colony, shall, before any such Vessel shall be Cleared outwards, enter into a Bond to Her Majesty for the Payment of a sum equal to the Duties liable to be charged upon the Cargo of the said Vessel under the said recited Act, upon Herrings Exported in Bulk from this Colony; which said Bond shall be cancelled upon the production, within One Year after, the date of the said Bond, to the Officer in this Colony appointed to receive Duties, of a Certificate, from some Person duly qualified to grant; the same at the Port where such Vessel shall Enter and Discharge her Cargo, that such Herrings have been landed within the British dominions.
