13 Victoria – Chapter 8

An Act to continue an Act passed in the Sixth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to revive and amend an Act passed in the Third Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled 'An Act to establish the Fees and Costs chargeable in the several Police Offices and Courts of Sessions in this Colony." (Passed 30th April, 1850.)

Whereas an Act was passed in the Sixth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to revive and amend an Act passed in the Third Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled 'An Act to establish the Fees and Costs chargeable in the several Police Offices and Courts of Sessions in this Colony," which said Act has been continued to the present time, and shortly will expire:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, that the said recited Act, and the several clauses and provisions thereof, shall be and the same are hereby continued for the period of Three Years, and from thence until the end of the then next session of the Legislature.
