14 Victoria – Chapter 12

An Act to continue an Act passed in the fourth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to regulate the Packing and Inspection of Pickled Fish for Exportation from this Colony." (Passed 31st May, 1851.)

Whereas an Act was passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to regulate the Packing and Inspection of Pickled Fish for Exportation from this Colony," which, as was therein declared, was to continue and be in force for Four Years, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Legislature: And Whereas the said Act has been continued to the present time, and will shortly expire, and it is therefore expedient that the said Act should be continued for a further period:

Beit therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, That the said recited Act, and every Clause, Matter and Thing therein contained, shall be and the same are hereby continued in full force and effect for One Year, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Legislature.
