

Laws of Her Majesty's Province of Newfoundland, passed in the year 1863.

26 Victoria – Chapter 14

An Act to Suspend the Operation of an Act passed in the Third Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act to Encourage the Killing of Wolves in this Colony.” (Passed 25th March, 1863.)

Whereas an Act was passed in the Third Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act to Encourage the Killing of Wolves in this Colony;” and it was amongst other things therein enacted that the said Act should be and continue in force for Two Years, and until the end of the then next Session of the Legislature; and whereas by an Act passed in the Twenty-first Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act to Revive and Continue an Act entitled ‘An Act to Encourage the Killing of Wolves in this Colony,’” the said herein first recited Act was continued in force for Ten Years from the Tenth Day of May Anno Domini One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Eight; and whereas it is expedient to suspend the operation of the said Acts, except in certain cases hereinafter provided: Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:

- I. That the operation of an Act passed in the Third Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act to Encourage the Killing of Wolves in this Colony,” and the operation of an Act passed in the Twenty-first Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled “An Act to Revive and Continue an Act entitled ‘An Act to Encourage the Killing of Wolves in this Colony,’” shall be and the same, is hereby, suspended.
- II. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, if he deem it expedient, by His Proclamation, at any time to declare the said Acts in full operation in any District or Districts of this Colony, and to remain in operation for such length of time as the said Proclamation may prescribe.
