28 Victoria – Chapter 13

An Act to provide for the erection of Bridges across Colinet River and Rocky River, on the main line of Road from St. John's to Placentia. (Passed 7th April, 1865.)

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the erection of Bridges across Colinet River and Rocky River, on the main line of Road from St. John's to Placentia:

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:

- I. It shall and may be lawful for the Receiver General, and he is hereby authorized, to raise by loan, from such persons as will advance the same, and in such manner as the Governor in Council may direct, and at the lowest rate of interest at which the same may be obtained, a sum not exceeding Three Thousand Two Hundred Dollars, to be applied and expended in the erection and completion of Bridges across Colinet River and Rocky River, on the main line of Road from St. John's to Placentia, on such places and at such points on the respective Rivers as may be selected by the Board of Works for such purpose.
- II. The Bridges for which provision is herein made, shall be erected and completed in accordance with the plans and specification prepared and approved by the Board of Works, and under the supervision and control of the said Board.
- III. The Receiver General shall, and he is hereby authorized and empowered, upon obtaining such a loan or any part thereof, to grant and issue one or more Debentures, to be numbered in succession from one upwards; which Debentures shall be in the form contained in the Schedule to this Act, and shall be issued for sums not less than Two Hundred Dollars, and shall be signed by the Receiver General and countersigned by the Colonial Secretary, and shall be assignable and transferable by endorsement thereon.
- IV. There shall be deducted from the amounts annually voted for the Road from Holyrood to Placentia, for Local Roads in the District of Placentia, for the Burin and Garnish Road, and for the Road from Harbor Britain to Gaultois, in such proportions as may be fixed by the annual Road Act, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars; to be applied, in the first instance, to the payment of interest on the Debentures to be issued by virtue of this Act, and also to form a Sinking Fund for the repayment of the amount borrowed, and for which the said Debentures may have been issued.
