Whereas it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-fifth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act for the Protection of the Herring and Salmon Fisheries on the Coast of this Island, and for other purposes."

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:—

The "Point Rosey" mentioned as a limit in the Fourth Section of the hereinbefore in part recited Act, is hereby declared to be the "Point Rosey," or "Point Enragee," on the Western Coast of this Island, and near Cape Bay, in the District of Burgeo and La-Poile [LaPoile].
