29 Victoria – Chapter 18

An Act to make provision for the management of Public Wharves. (Passed 1st May, 1866.)

Whereas it is expedient to make provision for the management of Public Wharves.

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:—

- I. It shall be lawful for the Justices, in Session, in the several Districts of this Colony, to make and establish, from time to time, Rules and Regulations for the control and management of Public Wharves within their several jurisdictions, and to fix and establish Fees and Rates of Wharfage; and such Rules and Regulations, Fees and Rates, being approved of by the Governor in Council, shall have the force and effect of Law.
- II. Such Rules and Regulations shall be posted up in some conspicuous place adjacent to the Wharf for which the same shall be prescribed.
