An Act to amend an Act passed in the Nineteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to regulate the Granting of Licenses for the Wholesale of Wines, Spirituous and Malt Liquors." (Passed 1st May, 1866.)

Whereas it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the Nineteenth year of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to regulate the Granting of Licenses for the Wholesale of Wines, Spirituous and Malt Liquors":

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:

- I. Instead of Two Gallons, mentioned in the first section of the said Act, for Sale by Wholesale of Wines, Spirituous and Malt Liquors, One Gallon shall be inserted.
- II. Instead of the amount mentioned in the third section of the said Act for a License to sell thereunder, Forty Dollars shall be paid: Provided that no person so licensed shall sell a less quantity than One Gallon at any one time, and shall otherwise be subject to the provisions of the said Act.
