30 Victoria – Chapter 15

An Act to amend the Acts for the Encouragement of Education in this Colony. (Passed 26th April, 1867.)

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Acts for the Encouragement of Education in this Colony. Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:—

That when the Protestant Boards of Education for St. John's and Brigus, shall make satisfactory arrangements between themselves with regard to funds for the erection of a School House, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, by Proclamation, to be published in the Royal Gazette, to declare that the St. John's Board shall have embraced within its jurisdiction that part of the District of Harbour Main lying between Horse Cove and Indian Pond, inclusive; and the Educational District of Brigus, aforesaid, shall consist of and include all that part of the Electoral District of Brigus, lying between South side of Northern Gut, in Port-de-Grave, Salmon Cove, and Indian Pond, exclusive.

II. The Saint John's Board shall thereafter be entitled to the proportionate annual Capitation Money of the place so transferred for Educational purposes, according to the Act 21st Vic., Cap. 7.
