30 Victoria – Chapter 4

An Act to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to regulate the Inland Posts of this Colony." (Passed 26th April, 1867.)

Whereas it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to regulate the Inland Posts of this Colony."

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:—

The Twenty-fifth Section of the Act passed in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to regulate the Inland Posts of this Colony," be, and the same is, hereby Repealed; and that instead of the rate chargeable by the said Section on Newspapers or Printed Papers, opened and re-directed, there shall be charged One Cent on any such Papers, if prepaid by stamp, and Two Cents, if not so prepaid: Provided that all such Newspapers and Printed Papers, deposited for despatch by the Government Coastal Steamer, shall be transmitted, free of charge, to the Post or Way Office nearest to the person to whom directed.
