Whereas it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of Her present
Majesty, entitled “An Act to make provision for the constitution of a Marine Court of Enquiry in this
Colony.”

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, in Legislative Session
convened, as follows:—

The Seventh and Tenth Sections of an Act passed in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of Her present
Majesty, entitled “An Act to make provision for the constitution of a Marine Court of Enquiry in this
Colony,” shall be, and the same are hereby Repealed.
