PASSED IN THE FIRST SESSION OF THE THIRD PARLIAMENT.

Sandwich, Nizgara and York, on the fecond Tuelday in the months of January, April, July and October.

And that the faid Courts of General Quarter Seffions of the Peace in and for the District of London thall be holden in the-town of Charlotteville, on the fecond Tuefday in the months of March, June, September and December.

And that the fait Courts of General Quarter Seffions of the Peace in and for the Midland Diffrict shall be holden in the town of Adolphus Town on the fourth Tuesday in the month of January, and on the second Tuesday in the month of July and in the town of Kingston on the fourth Tuesday in the month of April, and on the fecond Tuesday in the month of October.

And that the Courts of General Quarter Seffions of the Peace in and for the diffict of Johnstown shall be holden in the town of Johnstown on the third Tuesday in the months of February and May, and on the fecond Tuesday in the months of August and November.

And that the Courts of General Quarter Seffions of the Peace in and for the Eastern District shall be holden in the town of Comwall on the fourth Tues--day of the months of January and April, and on the fecond Tuesday of the months of July and October.

HI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That the duties which are required by law to be done and executed by any perion or perions at or before the April fellions shall be done and executed at or before the June feffions in the diffrie of London, and at or before the May festions in the diffrict of Johnftown.

C H A P. VII.

An ACT to authorize the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Perfon administering the government to appoint Inspectors of Flour, Pot and Pearl ashes within this Province. [July oth, 1801.]

TTHEREAS it would be for the mutual advantage of buyers and fellers of Preamble. flour, pot and pearl albes, and tend to eftablish the credit of those articles in foreign markets, if means were adopted for the afcertaining the quality of tholeasticles when offered for fale within this Province ; Beit enacted by the King's most excellent Majesty by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Upper Cinada conffituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paffed in the Parliament

of Great Britain, entitled an A& to repeal certain parts of an A& paffed in the fourteenth year of his Majefty's reign, entitled an A& for making more effectual provision for the government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the government of the faid Province and by the authority of the fame; That from and alter the paffing of this AA it thall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or perfon administering the government for the time being, to appoint one or more perfons in every district of this Province at fuch place or places as he shall deem proper as Infpector or Infpectors of flour, pot and pearl alhes, and the faid Infpector or Infpectors, before he or they thall enter upon the execution of fuch office shall take the following oath :

Appointment in every diffrict, of Inspectors of flour pot and pearl aftes.

Oath to he taken by Inspectors.

II. I do fincerely fwear that I will faithfully and impartially, and according to the beft of my fkill and understanding execute the office and duty of an Infpector or examiner of flour, or pot and pearl athes (as the cafe may be) according to the true intent and meaning of an Act of this Province, entitled "an Act to authorize the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or perfon administering the government to appoint Infpectors of flour, pot and pearl affres within this Province." So help me God.

Method of examining flour, pot and pearl ashes, and marking the casks_in which they are containtd. III. And he it further enasted by the authority afore/aid, That it shall and may be lawful for any perfon or perfons having flour, pot or pearlashes for fale, to call upon the Inforstor to examine the fame, who is hereby authorized and required to examine fuch flour by boring the head of the cask and piercing through, the flour with the usual inftrument in order to prove whether it be honefily and truly packed, and to judge of its quality; and the faid Inspector shall declare the quality of the fame, by marking it as superfine, fine or middling, and if unfound or foured he shall also mark the same on the head of each cask, and in the case of pot and pearlashes, the Inspector is hereby authorized and required to unpack the cask or casks in which it is contained, and to repack the same, and he shall declare the quality thereof, by marking each cask as first, second or third fort, or merely falts as the case may be.

Fees allowed to the Inspectors.

IV. And be it jurther enacted by the authority aforefaid, That it fhall and may be lawful for fuch Infpector to alk and receive of and from the perfon calling upon him to fearch and examine flour, pot and pearl alhes as aforefaid, for every barrel of flour three pence, and for every calk of pot and pearl alhes one fhilling.
