## CHAP. I..

#### CHAP. II.

An Act to repeal part of an Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the Thirty-Eighth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intitled "an Act for the better division of this Province" and more effectually, to provide for the administration of Justice, by constituting the Counties of Prescott and Russell under certain modifications a separate istrict.
