e? by some literate person, or to compel the Sheriff to serve the same, wienit may be inconvenient or difficult for such Plaintiff his Attorney or Agent to do so: And whereas it is expedient to grant relief to the several Sheriffs in this Province in respect o: such service, and to make provision relative to the service of such process in future: Be it therefure enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Counc!l and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and moder the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entided "An Act to repeal cortain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, entilled - An Act tor making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North Anerica, and to make further provision frr the Government of the said Province" and by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this Act, no person other than Sheriffs and persons employed under them shall be entitled to receive mileage or other compensation on the service of any Process required by Law to be directed to the Sheriff of any District.

## C H.A.P. VIII.

An Act to explain doubts which have arisen respecting the right of persons holding a Licence to keep a House of Public Eintertainment to Retail Spirituous Liquors to be consumed out of their houses without any additional Licence.
[Passed 14th April, 1821.]

WHEREAS doubts have arisen whether by the Laws now in force any person having a Licence to keep a House of Public Entertainment may by virtue of such Licence sell Spirituous Liquors by retail to be consumed ont of his heuse. for removing such doubts, Be it hereby enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of anAct passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled "An-Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign. entitled 'An Act for making more effectula provision for the Goveriment of the Province of Quebec. in North America, and to make further provision for the Gnvernment of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for any person in this. Province duly Liceiced to keep a House of Public Entertainment for the retailing of Spirituous Liquors, to sell Wine, Brandy or other Spirituous Liquors by retail to be consuned out of his house in the same quantities as be may retail it within his house without any additional Licence for that purpose.
